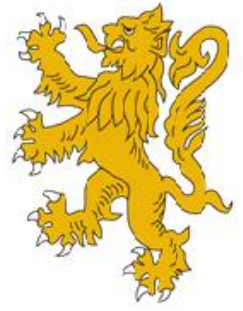


What does it mean to be a Church School?

Crompton House was gifted to the Church of England by Mary Crompton and Anne Ormerod in 1926 for the purpose of providing education (religious, moral and social) for the children within the Manchester diocese, and any other activity that meets the spiritual, moral, or social needs of the community.



Our school vision Statement aligns with the trust deeds:

As a Church of England School, we want everyone to know they are made and loved by God who longs for them to experience life in all its fullness through Jesus Christ.

Flowing out of this vision, we have 3 core values:

Loving God: we place prayer, worship, and spiritual growth at the centre of school life.

Caring for Each Other: we live out Christian values in our relationships with one another.

Achieving Excellence: we encourage and enable our school community to flourish.

At Crompton House, we seek to secure transformational outcomes for our students by combining academic rigour with a rounded approach to personal, spiritual, moral, and social development, rooted in our Christian heritage and school culture and traditions.
