There is a commitment to ensure that new Governors are given the necessary information and support to fulfill their role with confidence. The process is seen as an investment, leading to more effective governance and retention of governors.

We aim to:

- Welcome new governors to the Governing Body and enable them to meet other members
- Encourage new governors to visit the school to experience its atmosphere and understand its ethos
- Allow new governors to meet the Head Teacher, staff and children
- Explain the partnership between the Head Teachers, school and Governing Body
- Explain the role and responsibilities of governors
- · Give background material on the school and current issues
- Allow new governors to ask questions about their role/the school
- Explain how the Governing Body and its committees work
- Allow new governors to join committee(s) to balance out strengths and skill sets

The Chair of Governors will coordinate:

A welcome to the Governing Body by the Chair	
A meeting with the Head Teacher to visit the school, with a briefing about the school priorities	
An opportunity to meet informally with an existing governor who will act as their mentor	
Being accompanied to their first full Governing Body meeting by their mentor (if required)	
The opportunity to review their first meeting with their mentor
